Fire Drill Evacuation & Lockdown

This month, we will be practicing fire drills and lockdowns. Here are the other drills that may be called throughout the year, but are not necessarily practiced.

Classroom Hold Used to keep students in classrooms for medical situations, RCMP arrest, etc.

Shelter in Place Used to move and keep staff and students indoors due to environmental situations such as chemical spills, blackouts, explosions, or extreme weather.

Hold and Secure Used to move and keep staff and students indoors for ongoing situations outside of the school that involve potential danger including security threats or criminal activity. This could potentially lead to a lockdown.



RE: New Alertus Bus Notification System

We are excited to inform you that St. Paul Education Regional Division No. 1 has implemented a new bus notification system for parents/guardians. This system is called ALERTUS and will send push notifications (pop-up message on your phone) to your cell phone advising you of any delays/cancellations or other significant changes to a respective bus route(s).

In order to utilize this notification service, you will be required to download the free ALERTUS Recipient App. The app is available on the App Store for Apple devices and the Google Play Store for Android devices. The app will allow you to choose notifications specific to your child's/children's bus route (instructions are included with this letter).

As always, our top priority is student safety and Alertus is another tool to provide you with timely and accurate information. Please note that in more serious situations you will still receive a personal phone call from your bus driver or a St. Paul Education employee.

The "Bussing Schedule" on the website will still continue to be updated.

If your child rides a bus, we encourage you to sign up. If you are having trouble logging in or require additional assistance please call our St. Paul Education office at 780-645-3323.




